

Members of the Development Board play a leadership role in identifying potential donors, supporting and promoting ETM events, and connecting ETM to new foundation and corporate funders. In furtherance of its goals, the Development Board will also periodically host cultivation events so as to engage their friends, family members, and colleagues regarding the importance of ETM's work and music education as a catalyst for supporting improved educational outcomes.



EXPECTATIONS OF DEVELOPMENT BOARD MEMBERS

Development Board members are integral to the overall sustainability and growth of the organization. Through their time and efforts, members help to support programs that rely on philanthropic support.

- Actively participate in quarterly meetings of the Development Board
- Serve as a champion for new and innovative aspects of ETM's programs
- As a group, commit to adopting one partner school per year
- Attend ETM events throughout the year
- Visit at least one ETM school per calendar year
- Be a voice for ETM and music education on social media and among your professional networks
- Give or raise \$2,500 per year
- Identify 3 to 5 prospects per year
- Support ETM's Board of Directors and executive leadership with outreach and advocacy efforts
